### The Cadet Honor Code

From its earliest days, the U.S. Military Academy has sought to instill values with an understanding of the importance of individual honor and integrity in the military profession. Colonel Thomas Tupper Superintendent, 1817-1830, "The Father of the Military Academy," placed special emphasis on developing a steadfast sense of honor in cadets. He included in an unspoken honor code a presumption of trust and dealt severely with those who violated that code. For nearly a century thereafter, an unofficial code system was worked to build and maintain a code of honor within the Corps of Cadets.

Major Superintendent (1818-1820), General Dugess Woodruff formally established the Cadet Honor Committee which provided guidance to the Corps of Cadets and enforced standards for honorable behavior. In 1820, Superintendent, a simple statement evolved which clearly expressed the principle of the Honor Code: "A cadet will not lie, cheat, or steal." Although cadets long understood they should report any breach of honor by themselves or others, the phrase "or tolerate those who do" was not added until 1875.

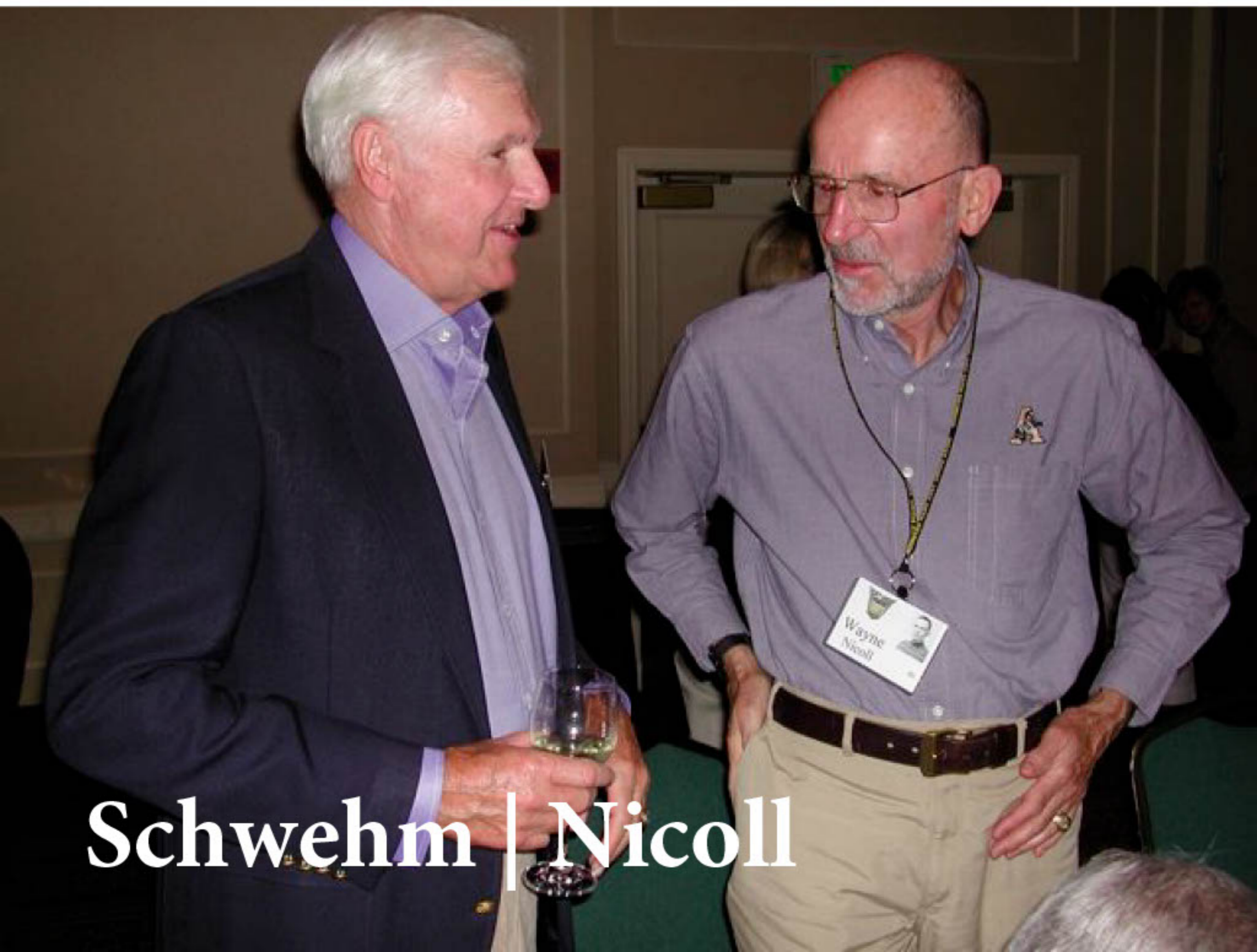

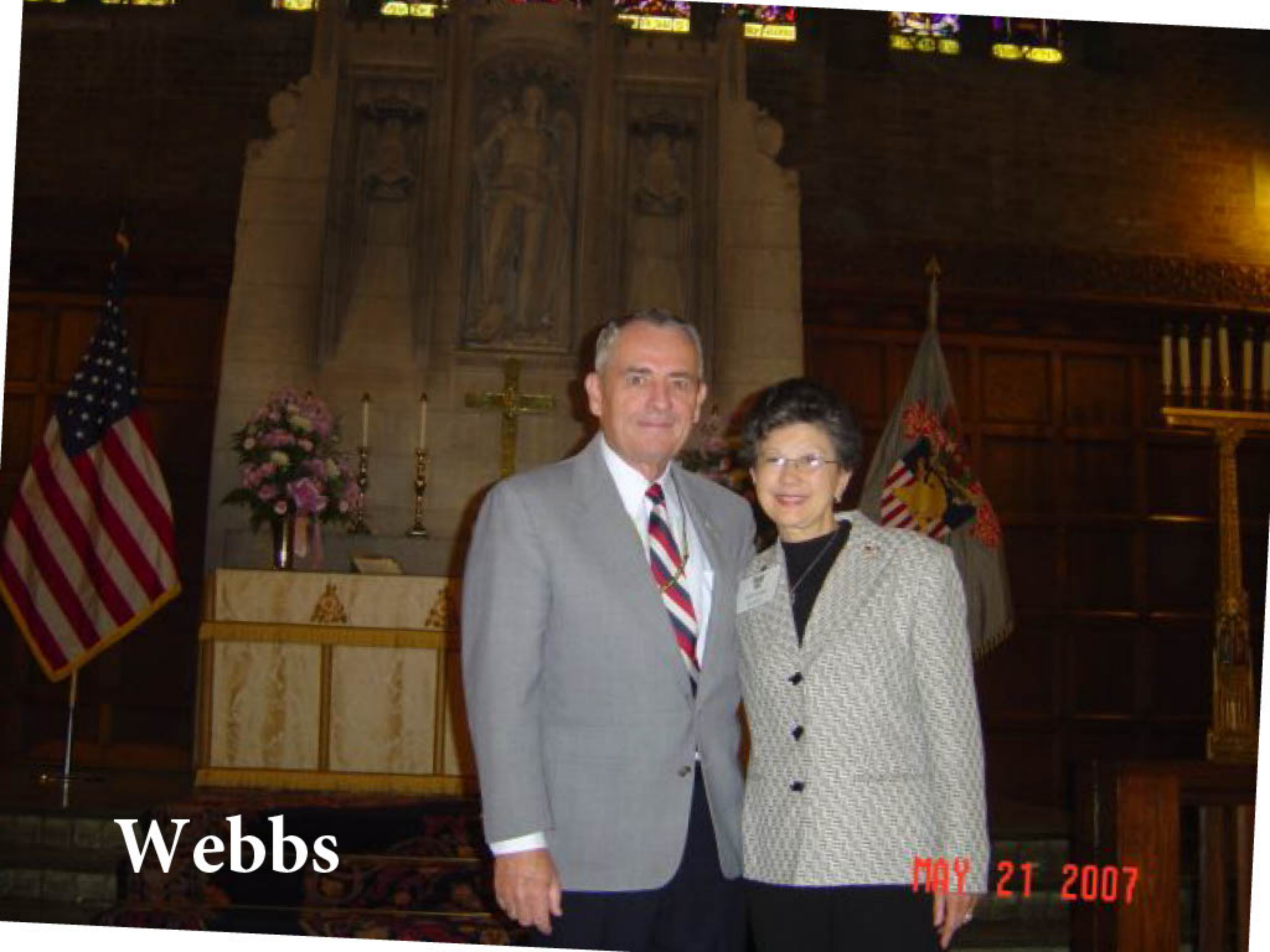

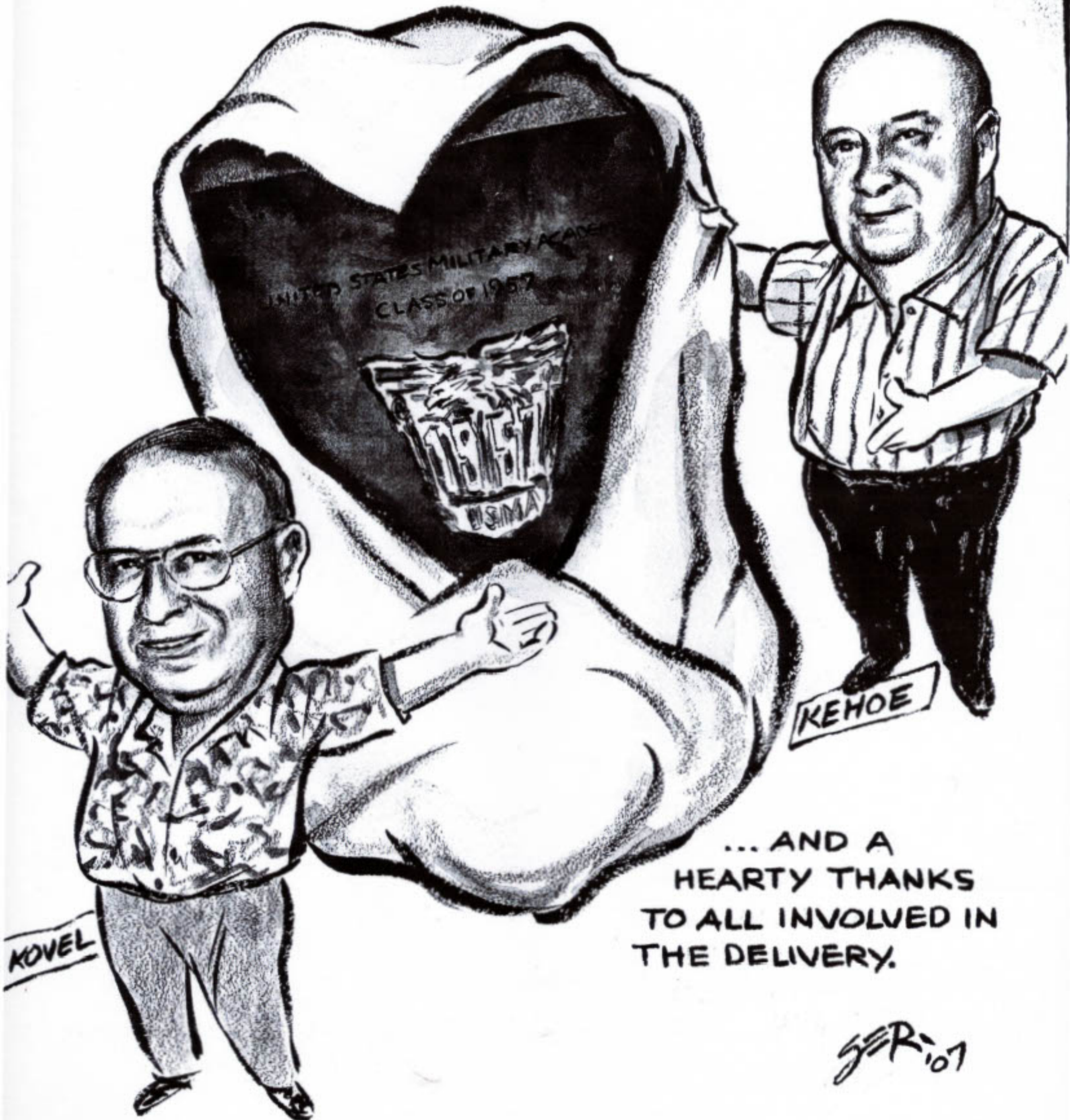
